- 4. Point difference from all pool matches
- 5. Total points scored in all pool matches
- 6. Drawing of lots


The 3 teams ranked 1st in each pool, plus the 1st placed team of the 3 teams ranked 2nd

<5th-8th Place decider Tournament>

The 2nd and 3rd placed teams of the teams ranked 2nd in each pool, plus the 1st and 2nd placed teams of the teams ranked 3rd

<9th-12th Place decider Tournament>

The 3rd placed team of the teams ranked 3rd in each pool, plus the 3 teams ranked 4th



^{*}The draw will be decided by lottery, with an additional adjustment to avoid teams from the same pool in the Pool Stage facing each other in the first round.

*If teams are tied at fulltime, then the winner will be determined by the following criteria in that order:

1. Number of tries

2. Number of penalty tries

3. Number of conversions

4. The team to score the first try

5. The team to score first

6. If the score is 0-0, both teams select 5 players for a kicking competition

7. If still tied, a second sudden-death style kicking competition

NB In case the score is even at full time in the Final, the two finalists will share the trophy.
