## COMPETITION FORMAT (Boys)

### Pool Stage (25 min. half)

The 16 teams competing will be grouped into four pools of four teams (Round robin)

\*The following number of match points will be awarded for each pool stage match:

Win - 4 points    Draw - 2 points    Loss - 0 point

\*Under either of the following conditions a bonus point will be awarded.

Scoring 3 tries or more than the opposition in a match - 1 point

Loss by 7 points or less - 1 point

\*The ranking of each pool shall be determined in the following criteria


### Place Decider Tournament (30 min. half)

<1st-4th place decider tournament> played by the 1st placed teams of Pool A-D

<5th-8th place decider tournament> played by the 2nd placed teams of Pool A-D

<9th-12th place decider tournament> played by the 3rd placed teams of Pool A-D

<13th-16th place decider tournament> played by the 4th placed teams of Pool A-D



The pairings for the first round of each tournament will be decided by drawing lots.

\*If teams are tied at fulltime, then the winner will be determined through the following sequential criteria:

| 1. Number of tries                 | 2. Number of penalty tries | 3. Number of conversion |
| 4. The team to score the first try | 5. The team to score first |                         |
6. If the score is 0-0, both teams select 5 players for the kicking competition.  
7. If still tied, the kicking competition on a "sudden-death" basis is held.

In the final and place decider matches, if the scores are equal at the full time, the match shall be a draw. In the final, the two teams will share the trophy.
